

IN OCTOBER 2007, I WAS HONORED to accept the 2007 Station of the Year award from the New Hampshire Association of Broadcasters (NHAB) on behalf of New Hampshire Public Television, its dedicated staff and our loyal supporters. The award is a tribute to our excellence in broadcasting and public service. Here are just some of the reasons why we were recognized in FY08:

Programming. By providing exceptional PBS programs, educational and community initiatives, NHPTV-produced programs such as Windows to the Wild, NH Outlook, Granite State Challenge and Autumn's Passage, as well as excellent locally focused specials (Communities and Consequences, Augustus Saint-Gaudens: Master of American Sculpture and A League of Our Own: NH and the American Craft Movement), NHPTV demonstrates its commitment to the state and region. And our programs continue to garner awards: nine Tellys; three from the Associated Press Broadcasters; and four from NHAB.

Digital transition messaging campaign. To alert viewers about how the switch from analog to digital transmissions on February 17, 2009 will affect them, NHPTV began a messaging campaign in 2007. We are encouraging viewers to contact us with questions. Additionally, NH Outlook produced a "DTV 101" special.

Telling New Hampshire's War Stories. In conjunction with the premiere of Ken Burns' acclaimed World War II documentary, The War, NHPTV initiated its "NH War Stories" effort to collect and preserve these stories. Through our Knowledge Network's student documentary project, we trained teachers to conduct oral histories, and invited students to submit films about veterans and those affected by war. The project culminated in a recognition ceremony in June, an opportunity to meet Ken Burns, and the students' films were posted on nhptv.org/thewar. Also, NH Outlook produced two programs featuring WWII stories from New Hampshire's own communities.

Our LiveFIT NH community engagement initiative, which encourages healthy eating and physical activity in children and adults, was selected to serve as a model to other PBS stations for health and nutrition programming and outreach efforts.
